Regular duties include designing newspaper and magazine ads, posters, flyers, rack cards, CD and DVD packages and concert programs. Additional duties will include public affairs. Must have a complete understanding of how to prepare finished artwork for publication. Will deal directly with printers during publication phase of projects. Must be proficient in Adobe Photoshop, PageMaker and Illustrator. Photographic experience necessary. Musical knowledge a plus. Submit portfolio of published artwork in black and white and color, photographs, resume and full-length photo.

Position is for permanent assignment to The U.S. Army Band “Pershing’s Own” in Washington, D.C. Applicants must pass a physical examination and meet all standards to enlist in the Armed Forces. Maximum age at time of enlistment is 34. To ensure suitability for support of White House performances, candidates will undergo an extensive background investigation.

In addition to a rewarding musical experience, members enjoy a full range of military benefits to include medical and dental care, 30-days paid vacation a year, a permanent duty assignment to Ft. Myer, Virginia, and educational benefits such as the College Loan Repayment Program which can help pay off existing college loans up to \$65,000.
